# Overview and Timeline

- The Narotam Sekhsaria Foundation Scholarship Programme is designed for students looking to pursue postgraduate studies at prestigious institutions in India or abroad.
- It is a merit-based scholarship, awarded to Indian students who have a consistently high academic record.
- The programme offers full and partial scholarships as interest-free loans.
- Selected candidates under this scheme will get a scholarship amount up to INR 20 lakhs.
- Selected scholars are assigned a mentor to guide them in their development as professionals, and motivate them to strive for excellence.
- Applications must be submitted online by 16 March 2023. Chosen candidates will have to attend an interview sometime during May/June 2023.

## Eligibility

- Applicant must be an Indian national, residing in India.
- Applicant must be below 30 years of age as of January 31, 2023.
- Applicant must have graduated from an accredited Indian University. Students in their final year of the degree course or those awaiting results are also eligible.
- Applicants planning to pursue postgraduate studies (masters or PhD) at top ranking institutions from Fall 2023.
- Applicants who have applied and are awaiting an acceptance from the university are also eligible to apply.
- The award of scholarship is subject to securing admission.

#### **Application Process**

- In order to apply, head to <a href="https://webportalapp.com/sp/login/narotam\_application\_portal">https://webportalapp.com/sp/login/narotam\_application\_portal</a> and register your profile. Once registered, the applicant must log into the online application portal using the email address and password created during the registration process.
- Applicants must pay INR 500 online in order the access the application form.
- Applicants must fill the details in 'Full Application Part 1-2-3' and submit the form. Once you submit your application, an automated confirmation email will be sent to the registered email address.
- Applicants shortlisted for the next phase of the selection process will be required to upload a set of documents.
- Shortlisted candidates will need to attend in-person interviews in Mumbai, which will be scheduled between April and June 2023.
- Selected scholars usually hear about the outcome at the end of June.

#### Application Form: Phase 1

- Applicants will be asked for the following details in the application form:
  - Personal information
  - Educational qualifications
  - Professional background
  - Proposed course of study
  - Other sources of funding
  - Extracurricular activities and other achievements
- Applicants will also be asked to submit a Statement of Purpose, explaining the following:
  - o What are you career goals?
  - How are your proposed universities and programmes relevant to the above?
  - Why have you chosen this field? If you are changing fields, then provide reasons for the same.
- Applicants will also be expected to write an essay telling their life story, and highlighting any personal
  qualities, talents, accomplishments, contributions or experiences that are important to them.
- Applicants will be asked for two references.
- Please note that the application form can ONLY be submitted online.

## **Application Documents: Phase 2**

Those candidates selected for the next phase (after submitting the application form) will be required to submit the following documents:

- Attested copies of the mark sheets of all years of the undergraduate study and post-graduate study, if any.
- Attested copies of score cards of any qualifying examination taken (e.g. GRE, GMAT, CAT, GATE, etc.)
- Acceptance letter with the fee structure
- Two Reference Letters
- Any document indicating an award of any other funding, scholarship, fee waiver, etc.
- Latest Income Tax Returns of parents
- Attested copy of the passport

Apart from the above-mentioned documents, the Foundation may request the applicant to submit any other document required to verify the details provided.

#### Interview: Phase 3

The interview panel consists of 7-10 panelists, some of whom have area-specific expertise.
