#### Overview

- The Jharkhand Overseas Scholarship Scheme, officially titled, 'Marang Gomke Jaipal Singh Munda Overseas Scholarship' is administered by the Government of Jharkhand.
- It provides scholarships to up to 25 Jharkhand residents belonging to SC, ST, OBC, and minority communities to pursue higher education abroad.
- The scholarship is available for a Masters or MPhil program to be pursued in United Kingdom and Northern Ireland from any of the 110 recognised universities.
- The scholarship covers tuition fees, cost of air passage, annual maintenance allowance, visa fees, medical insurance premium.
- Candidates will be required to fill an online application form for the scholarship.
- An interview will be conducted of shortlisted candidates.
- For selection, 1st priority shall be given to those candidates who have already obtained an offer letter of admission from the selected universities in the UK/ Northern Ireland. 2nd priority shall be given to those candidates who have successfully qualified/passed IELTS/GRE/TOEFL.

#### **Tentative Timeline**

- The last date for submission of application is 15 May 2023.
- A webinar will be conducted for interested applicants on 15 April 2023 and 15 May 2023.
- The applications will be assessed between 1 June 2023 to 15 June 2023.
- Interviews of selected candidates will be held between 16 June 2023 to 30 June 2023.
- Final list of selected and waitlisted candidates will be published between 1 July 2023 and 15 July 2023.
- Pre-departure workshop for selected candidates will be held early August 2023.
- Final scholarship award ceremony will be held on 28 August 2023.

## Eligibility

- Only available to Jharkhand residents (domiciles) belonging to ST, SC, OBC, and Minority communities.
- Candidates below the age of 35 years are eligible to apply.
- Candidates must have applied for a Masters or MPhil Programme in one of the 31 disciplines / subjects recognised by the Government.
- Candidates must have applied to one of the 110 universities listed on their websites as universities eligible for the scholarship.
- The annual income should not exceed 12 lakh per annum.
- Candidate has to be the first member of the family who is applying for the scholarship.
- Parent of the applicant must not be a minister in the State of Jharkhand or Government of India.

## **Application Process**

- Candidates must fill the online application form available at <a href="https://mgos.jharkhand.gov.in/">https://mgos.jharkhand.gov.in/</a> by 15 May 2023.
- The application form has the following components to be filled personal information, academic/ professional qualifications, work experience, UK/ Northern Island University information, supporting documents, declaration.
- Candidates will have to upload essential documents along with self-attested photocopies.
- Candidates will be required to detail their academic/professional qualifications and work experiences along with supporting documents to verify.
- It is not required to have an offer letter at the time of application; candidates will only have to provide information about the universities where they have applied for admission. However, for selection, priority is given to candidates with an offer letter.

# Statements of Purpose

Candidates will be required to write two Statements of Purpose of 500 words each:

- A 500 word Statement of Purpose for applying to the chosen programme.
- A 500 word Statement of Purpose answering the question 'Why would you be chosen as a Marang Gomke Jaipal Singh Munda Overseas Scholar Programme?'

## **Supporting Documents**

The application form requires you to upload the following documents:

- Photograph
- Scanned copy of signature
- Domicile Certificate (self-attested copy of online residential certificate issued by competent authority)
- Caste Certificate (self-attested copy of online caste certificate issued by the competent authority of the area of residence. For minority applicants, they will need to attach a self-declaration certificate))
- Income Certificate (Total annual income from all sources for the year 2021-2022, self-attested copy of income tax returns of parents. In case the applicant is unable to submit the above, the applicant must submit a self-declaration of income.)
- Offer letter from university (only if one has received it; it is not compulsory to provide an offer letter at the time of application)
- Self-attested mark sheet along with passing certificate for I. Matriculation II. Intermediate III. Graduation and Post Graduation (if any)
- Experience Certificates if applicable

#### Interview

- The interview is held in the Tribal Welfare Commission Office in Ranchi on a specified date.
- The interview is a combination of technical and personal where you will be asked questions related to your academic field, the course you have chosen to study, and the universities you have shortlisted; and questions related to your personal aspirations, interests, and development.
- The interview panel will potentially comprise of the Tribal Welfare Commissioner along with specialists like professors and researchers belonging to different academic fields.
